**Terry Campus Offers Student Scholarships for the Spring Semester**

DOVER- Fall is not the only time of year college students can take advantage of scholarship opportunities. Delaware Technical & Community College, Terry Campus wants new and returning students to know they can apply now for scholarships that will go into effect during the 2008 spring semester.

Vice President and Campus Director Daniel L. Simpson said he encourages students to take advantage of scholarship opportunities. "We do not want a single person to decide not to get an education because they think cannot afford it. We will help," he said.

Even though the maximum tuition for full-time students is only \$1,086 per semester, the financial load can become heavy once the cost of books, supplies, childcare and transportation are included.

The Terry Campus offers a variety of scholarships to help offset those costs. One new opportunity is the Michael Keith Sykes Scholarship which will award \$500 per semester to the selected applicants. To be eligible, students must be enrolled in the Business Administration or Accounting associate degree technology programs at the Terry Campus, be a Delaware resident between the ages of 21 and 30 and have a minimum high school cumulative GPA of 3.0.

Students must first complete a FASFA form at the Financial Aid Office in the Terry Building to be eligible for any scholarships. Interested parties should act quickly as scholarships will be awarded once an adequate pool of applicants is received.

“The little time it takes to apply for a scholarship is nothing compared to the benefits of relieving financial burden and gaining an education,” Mr. Simpson said.
