The Opening Season of Terry Campus Hawks Athletics

DOVER- Delaware Technical & Community College's Terry Campus men's and women's varsity soccer teams begin their first official season competing in the National Junior College Athletics Association (NJCAA) this week.

The opening home game for Hawks women's soccer will be Friday, Aug. 24 at 4p.m. against the County College of Morris Titans from Randolph, New Jersey. The men's first home game will be Tuesday, Aug. 4 at 4 p.m. against Delaware Tech's Stanton Campus.

"This season we hope to establish a strong foundation for great things to come," Terry Campus Athletic Director John Coveleski said when asked about his goals for the year. "We are playing a competitive junior college schedule and we plan on playing up to each team's level."

According to Coveleski, both teams need to be ready for the challenges a premier season holds. The Hawks' men's team will face Mercer Community College Oct. 1, who are ranked second nationally in the NJCAA.

"There's been great enthusiasm through the summer. We've established a strong corps of players," he said.
